Rewrite: **47 rounded to the nearest ten is 50 because 7 is 5 or greater so we round up.**

Rewrite: **82 rounded to the nearest ten is 80 because 2 is less than 5 so we round down.**

3. Fix the sentence: 35 rounded to the nearest ten is 30.

Rewrite: **35 rounded to the nearest ten is 40 because when the digit is exactly 5 we round up.**
