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Answer each question in one or two complete sentences.

- A flower field has 7 rows with 15 tulips each. After 18 are picked, how many remain? Show your steps.

Step 1:  $7 \times 15 = 105$  tulips total. Step 2:  $105 - 18 = 87$  tulips remain.
