Rewrite: **In cursive writing, most letters connect without lifting the pencil, using exit strokes to join one letter to the next.**

2. Fix the sentence:

Good cursive spacing means putting no gaps between words so the writing flows together.

Rewrite: **Good cursive spacing means leaving about one finger-width of space between words so each word is easy to read.**

3. Fix the sentence:

The letters b, o, v, and w connect to the next letter the same way as all other cursive letters.

Rewrite: **The letters b, o, v, and w have unique connections because their exit strokes end at a different height than most letters.**
